
Fencing Uniform and Equipment



Jacket - Comes in left and right-handed versions. The front has a v-shaped bottom edge ("gossard"); the back has a D-ring for adjusting the strap. Approx. price: \$60 (child) - \$325 (FIE regulation)

Knickers - May have elastic sewn-on suspenders or all-in-one jumpsuit construction. Approx.
price: \$45 (child) - \$220 (FIE regulation adult)

Plastron - A protective sleeve worn under the jacket on the weapons-arm side. Approx. price: \$20

Mask - Head and neck protection Approx. price: \$70 (child) - \$200

Long socks - Must completely cover the leg below the knickers. Approx. price: \$15

Shoes - Specialized fencing shoes or volleyball shoes are preferred. Approx. price: \$60 (child) - \$165

Weapon - Must be the correct blade length and grip type for your fencing level. The coaches can recommend the proper specifications. Approx. price: \$85

Equipment bag - May be a simple carrying bag "duffle" style or a wheeled bag appropriate for luggage checking when traveling. Approx. price: \$35 (duffle style) - \$250 (wheeled deluxe)

Body cord - (not shown) Connects electric weapon to scoring system. Get 2-prong foil cord.

Approx. price: \$20

Lamé - (not shown) For foil fencers only. Metallic vest for competition that allows electronic scoring of touches. Approx. price: \$110 (child) - \$210 (adult)

Glove - (not shown) Must be worn by all fencers for all weapons. Approx. price: \$15
